1 Format of the *.CSV file

1.1 Example CSV

Correct CSV export should be look like this :

<i>Auftrags-Nr,Kunde,Station,Template</i>	<i>HEADER</i>
<i>"000000124","Max Mustermann","Beschriftung ","0"</i>	<i>CONTENT</i>
<i>"000000344","NadineMustermann","Beschriftung ","1"</i>	<i>CONTENT</i>
<i>"000000127","Harald Mustermann","Beschriftung ","2"</i>	<i>CONTENT</i>

Rule1: Header is seperated with a kommata

Rule2: Content are written in-> "" ← and seperated with , (kommata) .

The exportname is important and should be named like this:

import_timestamp

import_YearMonthDayHoursMiniutesSeconds

EXAMPLE:

import_20150915102011

1.2 Usage

Put the import_yourTimeStamp in the ESLService → esIFTP_HOME→ Import folder .

After short time file will disappear. Delivered Informations can be used and displayed now.
